Who We Are: Immigration Counseling Service (ICS) is a non-profit legal organization that has offered legal services to immigrant communities in Oregon and Southwest Washington for almost 40 years. With offices in Portland and Hood River, ICS has recognized the need to expand our services into underserved areas, and has opened a monthly mobile legal clinic in Central Oregon, serving immigrants in central and eastern parts of the state. What We Do: We are lawyers and certified BIA representatives who work only on immigration matters. All are bilingual in English and Spanish, and have extensive experience in immigration cases. We are offering confidential, free consultations to people east of the Cascades who have questions regarding immigration matters.

If You Want Help: All appointments must be scheduled through Latino Community Association in Redmond – you must call 541.325.6837 or come in to the Latino Community Association office to schedule an appointment *ahead of* the scheduled dates, above. We cannot accept walk-ins. Each appointment is 30 minutes. All client conversations are held in strictest confidence.

Cost: There is no cost for the consultations. If after a consultation the lawyer and client decide to continue with representation, the lawyer will discuss fees and costs with the client. We are a non-profit organization, and our fees are structured for low income clients with few resources, especially those who have household incomes less than 200% of the federal poverty income guidelines.
